On Monday, December 10 (holiday): 7:00~7:30 Confirmation of registration, 8:00 Bouldering qualifications,


13:00 Bouldering final, 15:00 closing ceremony

This event was the first international competition for the Cambodian National team. Yan Fai and Sophea, who were selected at the Lotus Cup in August, participated in this competition under the supervision of Semrorn. All expenses were funded by Taica Corporation. Yan Fai had experienced the training project in Japan, but it was the first




The Asian Championship in Kurashiki, Tottori, Japan on November 7~11


