We in Japan are very blessed with good climbing facilities compared with people in Cambodia, where there are only two artificial climbing walls. There are more than 400 climbing gyms operating in Japan now. In addition to these, there are artificial walls built in public facilities such as schools, climbing training institutes, public gymnasiums, fire stations, etc.

The ACN is supporting "Sports Climbing," one sport among the 33 Olympic events, in Cambodia, which is one country among the many developing countries.

We are simply glad that climbing has become an Olympic event, which is a first step. Now we can think next about what we should do, and what we can do, and act toward our dream of participation in 2020.

All of the following were passed through the approval process and agreed upon:


Raising funds for the plan "Let Cambodian Climbers participate in the Tokyo Olympic Games,"

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07 Mt. Takao、 From the ACN's Desk We are sorry to report that Ms. Junko Tabei passed away. The ACN received her support through Hat-J (Himalayan Adventure Trust-Japan). We offer our deepest condolences to her friends and family, and wish them peace.

In the autumn of 2014, we got a call from the Hat-J office. They said they had collected mountain gear and sports gear to be given as presents at competitions in Cambodia and they asked us to come and pick them up by car. We drove a "Fit," a five-seater car there, and filled the car up with a lot of goods. Some of the presents still remain to use as prizes for our competition. (as mentioned on P.3)

After that, we saw Ms. Tabei in good health when she took a ferry to go to Mt. Misen during the Hiroshima Mountaineering Peace Festival. It has been only two years since then, but Mr. Hemtong, who came from Cambodia to attend the festival, and Mr. Tadao Ito, the former chairperson of the ACN, have also passed away.

Building a 50 meter pool in Cambodia was Mr. Hemtong's wish, and it was achieved. Since the JOCV recruited overseas volunteers to be swimming coaches in Cambodia, some Japanese may teach swimming in that pool next year.

Hat-J also invited high-school students from Fukushima to go hiking on Mt. Fuji, and this was destined to be the last trip to the mountains for Ms. Tabei. "Moi moi" -- "little by little" in Cambodia's Khmer language -- the ACN would like to continue to support the ambitions and dreams of Cambodian

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
